### Main barriers to educational achievement

(Based on our own research as well as recommendations from other sources.)

Emotional & behavioural issues (ability to focus and stay on task, social difficulties, anxiety, low self esteem)

Learning difficulties (may be general or more specific eg dyslexia)

Poor attendance and home circumstances.

#### How will barriers be addressed?

#### Spend

Emotional support for Extra Care children. HLTA spend time on a weekly basis with extra care children to give them opportunity to talk through issues and to gather information to support planning.

£592.17 ph x3 = £1776.51

Subsidised places on school visits, residentials, clubs and music lessons.

£744.35

Additional TA support in English and maths class in addition to specific interventions in order to accelerate learning. Specific intervention programme support including cookery

£466.84phx7 classes x3 hours daily=

£472.22ph x 25hrs =£11805.50

HT to monitor attendance patterns on a half termly basis with focus on below 90%, below 95% and persistent absence. Letters to parents to alert them of issues and impact on learning. Termly awards for children recognising good attendance and excellent work-habits.

#### Impact Measures

#### Impact

Lower incidence of behavioural issues. Children are more focussed in class and happier in friendships. Children able to articulate feelings to a trusted adult.

High compliance with Behaviour policy. Very low incidence of racist, homophobic or general bullying.

Children have made expected or better progress to narrow the gap.

Average attendance rises to national averages for PP. Reduced incidence of persistent absence.

Currently attendance for PP children is at 92.73%. This % is impacted by a small minority of very low attenders. This is being followed up and monitored.
