

2 week remote learning plan for Year 4

In the event of another lockdown and children need to stay at home, below is an outline of 2 weeks planning for Year 4 students to complete remotely. An exercise book with the work stuck in will be sent home with children, including further information for the activities where needed. Google Classroom for Year 4 is full of back up material and links for the class to follow. Where written work is produced this is to be in the exercise books provided. It will be expected that children complete Maths and English lessons daily plus a foundation subject, totalling around 3 hours work time every day. The foundation subject lessons can be done on any day.
