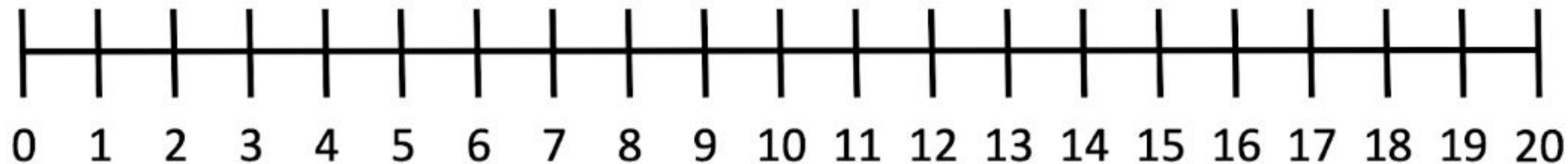
Applying Make 10 to differences (Part 2)
