


<p>English We will be considering child labour making links to previous learning in Geography on globalisation and the effects on the fashion trade. The children will write a persuasive letter to encourage future purchases of Fairtrade footballs for PE. VOCAB: globalisation, High Street fashion, Fairtrade, Child Labour Free Zone, emotive language, UNCRC</p>	<p>Maths This term's units are geometry, ratio, volume and continuous practice of arithmetic skills, problem solving and reasoning.</p>	<p>History Hook in: We will continue to study the local area by studying Famous and influential Norfolk folk across the ages. VOCAB: Boudica, Nelson, Edith Cavell, Elizabeth Fry, Robert Kett</p> 	<p>Science Hook in: 2 min short film We will learn what a light source is, where light comes from and how it travels. We will carry out an experiment to understand refraction and compare this with reflection. We will learn how we see light and colour and find out about different uses of light. VOCAB: shadow, light, straight, reflection, refraction, prism, split</p> 
<p>The children will be writing their memories of their time at Stibbard. VOCAB: diary, memorable experience, cohesive devices</p>	<p>PHSE BOOK: Can you see me? We will explore the medium of charcoal. Using a descriptive sentence as a stimulus children will make a set design out of mixed media, using torchlight for dramatic effect and make drawings using charcoal.
